PURPOSE: To request approval for acceptance of the award of CJCC Subgrant AW-ACFP-27-027 and delegation of signing authority for documents related to acceptance of this award to Chief Superior Court Judge William R. Oliver.

BACKGROUND / HISTORY: The Accountability Courts were awarded CJCC Subgrant AW-ACFP-27-027. The purpose of the State Accountability Court Program is to allocate state funds to local courts and judicial circuits of established specialty courts for the intent to fund the overall operational costs for these specialty courts. These specialty courts, such as drug court, effectively integrate evidence-based substance abuse treatment, mandatory drug testing, sanctions and incentives and transitional services in judicially supervised court settings with jurisdiction over substance abusing offenders.

The funds from this subgrant will be used by Drug Court to continue operations. Funds will be used to provide salaries for existing employees, compensate various specialized contractors for services provided such as surveillance, lab confirmations, treatment services, etc. Drug Courts offer intensive treatment along with court supervision to individuals who are in the criminal justice system and have been identified with a substance use disorder. These individuals would otherwise remain in the jail at the expense of the taxpayers. Having individuals participate in the drug court programs as an alternative to incarceration saves the taxpayers around \$4,000/year for each participant. This grant is effective July 1, 2026 with a termination date of June 30, 2027. The total grant is \$24,386.40 with \$445,728.40 in state funds and required 15% match of \$77,658.00. The funds for this match will come from collected participant fees and D.A.T.E funds; there is no anticipated cost to the county.

FACTS AND ISSUES:

- The funds for the 15% local match for this grant would come from participant fees and D.A.T.E funds.
 - Accountability Court programs save the County around \$4,000/year for each participant.
 - This grant is awarded annually to cover the operational cost of the program.
