Contract for Services County of Habersham State of Georgia

THIS CONTRACT AND AGREEMENT is made and entered into this _____ day of _____ 2024, by and between Habersham COUNTY, GEORGIA, a political subdivision of the state of Georgia, acting by and through its Board of Tax Assessors (herein, the "County") and McCormick Solutions a division of LMC Inc, (herein the "Company") for the purposes of providing services in the oversight of a computer software WinGAP conversion, provide certain services in connection with revaluation of all Real taxable Property in Habersham County, Georgia.

Original Scope of Service

Part 1- Conversion

Habersham County has elected to upgrade the county's CAMA system to WINGAP. The GAP GROUP team will be in charge of transferring data and initial training for the CAMA system. LMC Inc. dba McCormick Solutions will provide technical support oversight, 3rd party observations regarding data transfer and setup, ongoing training to the office for the implementation and use of WINGAP and play the part of the middleman serving to look out for the Assessor's interests as we move forward with the transition.

McCormick solutions will help guide the Assessor's office through dual setup and use of both CAMA systems providing offsite and onsite solutions to problems that will arise with switching databases. We will also serve Habersham County as professional representatives in regard to the conversion and dealing with technical and methodology concerns of the transition.

GAP GROUP will be responsible for data conversion, hardware and software setup and any training that initially comes with the conversion. McCormick solutions will serve as a mediator during this process and provide continued training for Commercial Schedule modules, Residential Schedule Modules, Rural Land Module, Urban Land Module, Accessory Schedule Module, and any other training necessary for the staff to move forward with the new CAMA system.

The company would need remote access to the CAMA system, by VPN or whatever means necessary. The Company would need adequate office space.

Part 2- 2025 digest after conversion to WinGAP -Commercial and Industrial revaluation

New schedules and tables will be established and entered in WinGAP

- Physical field review of all commercial and industrial properties. field reviews will consist of building classification, grading, observed condition, depreciation and measuring newly discovered additions or improvements.
- A photo of all the improvements will be taken.
- Tables and schedules will be in place to establish fair market value when properly applied.
- Office staff will be trained to use the new tables and schedules and to properly enter the data in the new CAMA system WinGAP
- This will take place for the 2025 digest year and based on the county converting from Bi Tech to WinGAP
